Are you for or against an initiative on behalf of Belgium with an aim of initiating talks concerning a treaty for the abolition of the nuclear weapons?



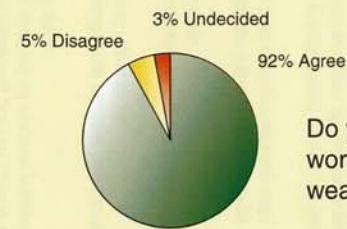
GERMANY

[Should] the nuclear weapons states... start getting rid of their own nuclear weapons as soon as possible? *



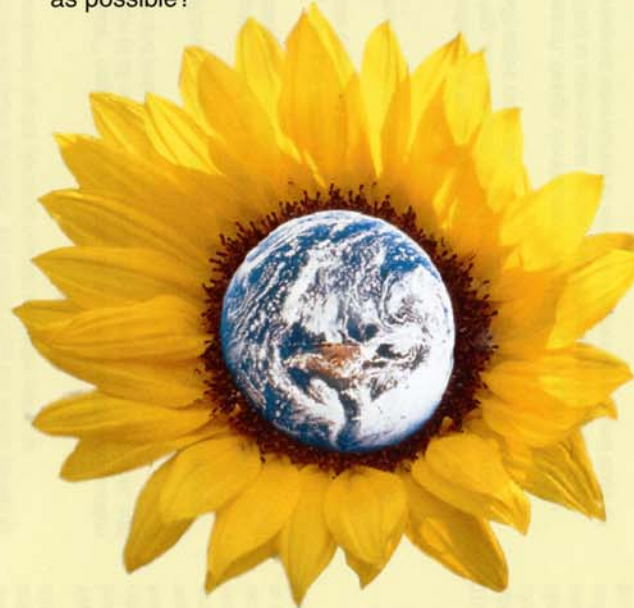
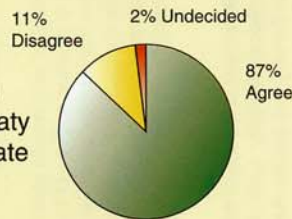
NORWAY

Do you think that Norway should work actively for a ban on nuclear weapons? *



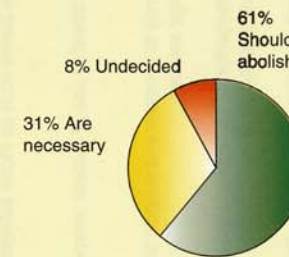

Do you agree that Britain should help to negotiate a global treaty to prohibit and eliminate nuclear weapons?



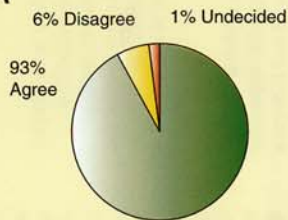
RUSSIA

Do you think that all nuclear weapons states should eliminate such weapons...? Or... is it permissible... [to] possess nuclear weapons for defense purposes? *



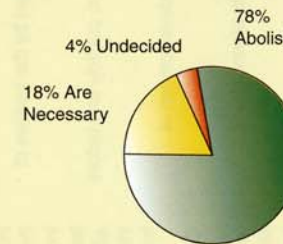
CANADA

Do you agree that Canada should take a leadership role in global negotiations to eliminate nuclear weapons?



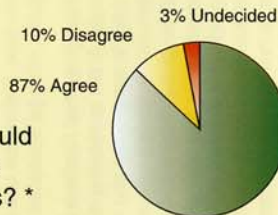

Do you think that all nuclear weapons states should eliminate such weapons...? Or... is it permissible... [to] possess nuclear weapons for defense purposes? *



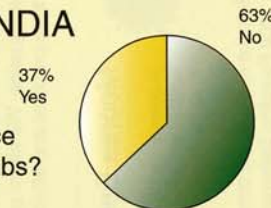

Do you agree the U.S. should negotiate an agreement to eliminate nuclear weapons? *



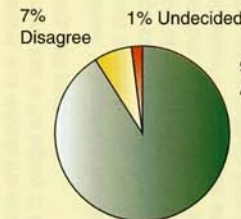
