



Proposal for the Nuclear Abolition 2000 General Assembly

Proposal: Formation of Network of NGOs and Institution "Nuclear-Free Future Group" towards the international negotiation process for the post-SDGs

The Hiroshima Organization for Global Peace (HOPE) is a multi-stakeholder NGO located in Hiroshima, Japan. With the goal of including the abolition of nuclear weapons in the post-2030 agenda, HOPE would like to propose the formation of the "Nuclear-Free Future Group" that will serve as a platform for civil society to join the UN post-SDGs negotiation process. To achieve nuclear-free future with no further delay, we would like to call for like-minded organizations/groups to join this collaborative endeavor.

HOPE believes that the legal approaches of NPT and TPNW need additional support to push the abolition agenda forward, and that the SDGs approach could be effective, in which countries around the world aim to solve a common global agenda. We hope to form a special interest group at UN for nuclear disarmament with the interested NGOs and institutions to advocate total elimination of nuclear weapons before the post-SDGs negotiations begin in earnest.
